

PLAN FILE SYSTEM

The plan filing system is divided into 2 major sections:

1. Overall Classification
2. Plan form size and number.

Section 1 is further broken into 3 sections:

- (i) 04 DM 15

The first two numerals inform as to the general information provided on the plan e.g.:

- 04 - Survey
- 03 - Planning
- 07 - Rock Mechanics

- (ii) 04 DM 15

The second two letters represent the location of the plan around the Mine Site or Island, e.g.:

- DM - Dolphin Mine
- BH - Bold Head Mine

- (iii) 04 DM 15

The final two numerals of this section represent various breakdowns complementary to the information provided in the first two sections, e.g.:

- 14 - 1:500 Scale Development
- 15 - 1:500 Scale Stopping

Section 2: Development plans for both mines. The smaller the number, the nearer the surface.

The layout of Section 2 stopping for both mines differs due to the type of orebodies.

Dolphin Mine has large vertical stopping areas and is therefore easily indexed by one set of 4 numerals with which ideally the last numeral changes by 1 every 3 metres or stopping lift.

However, in the plan number (e.g. 04 DM 15 - 1052) the first numeral represents the size of the plan, e.g.:

- 1 = A1
- 0 = A0
- 3 = A3

The final three numerals represent the simple numerical index. The smaller the number, the higher in the mine (or nearer the surface) that plan is.
