Legend

- Landscape Feature –**
- creek/drainage line
 - marshy area
 - break in slope
- Historical Feature (identified) –**
- track/tramway/railway, probable route; tramway/railway with sleepers
 - path/foot track/pack track; steps
 - building with extant foundations; building – likely footprint
 - chimney
 - stone construction; brick construction; concrete construction
 - artefact scatter
 - metal object – general; horizontal item; railway iron
 - timber object – post; horizontal timber
 - vertical cutting; slope
 - cut into slope (sloping walls)
 - trench (vertical walls) – open one side; four sided
 - shaft; underlay shaft; collapse into underground working
 - adit
 - entrance
 - portal
 - tunnel
 - mullock/tailings
 - water race/drain/channel (includes natural erosion feature)

 - stripped & levelled (& rehabilitated) tailings

SCALE


