## LOCALITIES FOR TUNGSTEN, &amp;c.

## Tungsten:

Balfour: 2 miles S.W. of township,  
 Interview River: near Coast,  
 Waratah: West Bischoff Mine,  
 Natone: near Blythe River,  
 Bluff River: south of Mt. Inglis,  
 Forth River: south west fall of Mt. Claude,  
 Mt. Pelion East: 22 miles south of Lorinna  
 and 5 miles North Mt. Pelion east.  
 Gladstone: within southern boundary of township,  
 Lotta: at Anchor and Liberator Mines,  
 Scamander: 6 miles N.W. of Tarmonth,  
 Constable Creek, Upper Scamander: 7 miles S.W.  
 of St. Helens,  
 Gipp's Creek, near Avoca and south of Ben Lomond,  
 Story's Creek: southern foothills of Ben Lomond,  
 King Island: occurrence of scheelite, near coast  
 South of Bold Point at Grassy,  
 Flinders Island.

## Bismuth and Tungsten:

Mt. Ramsay,  
 Mt. Heemskirk: on S.W. fall,  
 Remine:  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile E.S.E of Mayne's Tin Mine,  
 Zeehan: Oonah Mine,  
 Roseberry: Mt. Black Proprietary,  
 Moina: S. & M. Mine.

## Bismuth:

Murchison River: Kitson's blocks,  
 Ringville: Curtain & Davis Mine,  
 Mt. Read.

## Antimony:

Port Davey,  
 Lynchford: Hall's Creek,  
 Parson's Hood: Mt. Lindsay Mine,  
 Mt. Balfour: 10 miles S.E. of township, near  
 Frankland River,  
 Lefroy.

## Monazite:

Stanley River: upper reaches,  
 West Bischoff, Waratah,  
 Avoca: South Esk Mine,  
 Pioneer,  
 Mt. Stronach,  
 British Flag: North of Fraser River, in beach  
 sand (King Island),
