

MEMORANDUMUNDERGROUND WATER - MR. CUTHBERTSON,  
"LOWLANDS" CAMBRIDGE

Mr. Cuthbertson's area at "Lowlands", Cambridge was visited on 19th December, to assess the possibilities of a supply of underground water.

Mr. Cuthbertson was desirous of obtaining sufficient water to enable irrigation of crops to be carried out.

Whilst a supply sufficient for general household needs could be obtained there is no possibility of a supply of water sufficient for irrigation. Mr. Cuthbertson has been advised accordingly.
