MEMORANDUM:

On the 4th July I visited Mr. B.A. Jackson and discussed the alleged copper show with him. He tells me it is located on Swan Island, almost a mile west of the lighthouse, in a brown rock near the shore line; and extends several hundred feet. A sample was taken to Hobart (probably to the Government Analyst) on 9.9.10 by the late Capt. J. Holyman.

The Geological map shows dolerite on this Island but it may be wrong. I informed Mr. Jackson that the Department was always interested in mineral occurrences and that if the occasion arose, a trip would be made to the Island and he would be notified.
