MEMORANDUM

VISIT TO ZEEHAN 18TH - 22ND FEBRUARY, 1957

Monday, 18th February

Left Hobart 8 a.m. for Zeehan and arrived at 4 p.m.

Tuesday, 19th February

Went out to No. 6 Drill on the Veaudeaux lease Bore 9 (M - 14). Hole was completed and drill ready to commence jarring casing. All lines of casing recovered and started shifting machine to Hole No. 10 (M - 15).

Wednesday, 20th February

Rigged plant on the Bore No. 10 site and commenced laying water line.

Thursday, 21st February

Started drilling. NX size put in stand pipe and drilled on to 17 feet BX size. Ground very soft and losing water.

Went to Mines Department house in Wilson Street and fitted small bolts on three window adjustments also fitted five new panes in louvre window of laundry annexe and made arrangements with Mr. Max. Brumby to cut and burn all grass and brambles for a distance of 15 feet around all buildings on the allotment for £10.0.0. if acceptable to the Department.

It appears that J. Blake and W. Robinson are getting on reasonably well as workmates, and if there is any strained feeling, neither exhibited it whilst I was with them. J. Blake is picking the drilling up, but still has quite a lot to learn to be efficient as an operator.

Friday, 22nd February

Left Zeehan 8 a.m. and arrived Hobart 5 p.m.
