MEMORANDUM

UNDERGROUND WATER ON WOODSTOCK, TRIABUNNA

This is the property of Mr. J.B. Salmon and is situated immediately south of the township of Triabunna.

Two areas were indicated by Mr. Salmon where he desired a water supply. It is recommended that a bore should be put down in both areas. The southern is underlain by sandstone and the other by alluvial material and dolerite boulders probably overlying sandstone which should occur at no great depth.

It is expected that underground water could be struck at a depth of less than one hundred feet.
