MEMORANDUMUNDERGROUND WATER ON PROPERTY OF A.J. CUMMINS  
HAGLEY

This property is situated about two miles along the Whitmore Road, beyond the Hagley Station, from the Bass Highway.

It is underlain by Tertiary Sediments; clay sand and gravel beds. It is not known the exact position of sand beds under the clay so that no definite information could be given the farmer. Of wells sunk in the neighbourhood some are dry and some give ample supplies of water. Boring will thus be largely a matter of trial and error and can be accomplished either by a hand plant or post hole digger. Where sand beds are present they should occur within 30 feet of the surface.

These matters were discussed with Mr. Cummins and a tentative site agreed upon.
