MEMORANDUM

VISIT TO G 33 DRILL TRIABUNNA

Tuesday, 18th June

Left Hobart 9 a.m. after picking up six bags of coke from Gasworks. Arrived Triabunna at 11 a.m.

Driller now at Grindstone Bay with hole down 30 feet on Mr. Ferguson's property.

I delivered the coke, sisal rope, screw driver and Bull reel liner for drill.

Everything appeared OK and driller requested several items namely:-

1 wire handled flatter 2" face

one or two 8' to 10' pieces of steel tubing 6" to 7" inside diameter - almost any sort or condition within reason will do - to be used as surface stand pipe

2 pairs driller's gloves special type - double thumb and palm.

Left Triabunna at 5 p.m. and arrived Hobart at 7 p.m.
