MEMORANDUMREPORT ON AREAS EXAMINED ON REQUEST OF  
ABERFOYLE TIN N.L., ROSSARDEN, TASMANIA

In this report, the whole anticipated boring campaign of the Company has been condemned not on structural grounds but on the look of vein system at and near the surface. The only structural feature mentioned is a "highly sheared" zone which is described as a favourable circumstance. The only samples taken are those in country rock, 5 samples with an average width of 16 feet each. Otherwise tin values are quoted as "visual estimate", "no cassiterite seen" etc.

It is recommended that a boring campaign based on structural evidence as well as visible mineralization be sited in the vicinity of Johnson's area and possibly Egan's.

It should be noted that a boring campaign was recommended in a previous report by Geologist Robinson at the latter area.
