MEMORANDUMCLAY MATERIAL

A small sample of clay material from H.O. Targett, Calder (Private bag, Wynyard), has been examined. The material is a rather gritty clay containing grains of quartz averaging .05 mm. across. The colour is a very pale gray.

Such material may be of use in the ceramics industry, but is unlikely to be suitable for papermaking.
