MEMORANDUMJones and Hayes

The pipes were inspected by me in 1955. They were then not in use and the water-race which fed them was not full. The pipes have almost certainly lain idle since 1955 and may have deteriorated considerably.

The water-race in question is some seven miles in length and was a cause of worry to the previous lease holders, Haas Bros, who frequently complained that people resident along its length were in the habit of tapping it for water supplies for their own use.

A fresh inspection of the pipes and race would be necessary before a recommendation could be made.
