MEMORANDUMVISIT TO DIAMOND DRILL 10TH LEGION  
IRON ORE DEPOSIT ZEEHANTUESDAY 26th NOVEMBER, 1957

Left Hobart at 9 a.m. and arrived Zeehan at 5 p.m.

WEDNESDAY, 27th NOVEMBER, 1957

No. 1 drill hole stopped at 290 feet. All lines of casing jarred and recovered from drill hole. Rig dismantled and ready for shifting to drill site No. 2.

THURSDAY, 28th NOVEMBER, 1957

Went to abandoned Kapi mine and checked accessibility for getting drill plant to location. The old N.E. Dundas tramline is suitable for motor transport to close proximity of the mine. After that the track down to the mine is steep for last few hundred yards and only a vehicle similar to a crawler tractor could negotiate it. Later went to the Tenth Legion and packed and boxed diamond drill core and towed drill machine down to site number two. Picked out suitable access and position for drill pump to operate from main creek nearby to drill site.

FRIDAY, 29th NOVEMBER, 1957

Left Zeehan 8 a.m. and arrived Hobart 4 p.m.

Delivered entire core of Tenth Legion No. 1 drill hole at Hobart office.
