MEMORANDUM

A Geiger Counter, Phillips Monitor P.W. 4010 No. 3, issued to me on 28.8.56 cannot be accounted for. It was on loan for educational purposes and afterwards used in the Office and in the field. I last used it during March, 1957, and brought it back to the Office at the beginning of April, 1957. To the best of my recollection it was placed in a cupboard with items of microscope equipment. Subsequently, when it was required, it could no longer be found. There is no record of the instrument having been issued on loan at this time, and all enquiries have been without result.

During the same period four valuable specimens of telluride ore, loaned to me by another Office of the Department were missing from a specimen drawer in which they had been placed, and have not been recovered.

Since then a new lock has been placed on the office door.
