MEMORANDUM

In connection with the future of the campaign for boring for underground water an examination of the files on which the applications are recorded shows that there are still 50 applicants who are awaiting the bore plant. Of these people 10 are resident in the Triabunna - Orford district, 15 in the Tunnack - Oatlands district, 6 in the Smithton - Stanley area and 9 in the Hobart area.
