Applications for Water Bores

The following properties were inspected last week and recommendations made as follows.

E. Lyell, Colebrook

This property is situated near the top of a sandstone hill, rising 1000 feet above the valley floor at Eldon on the Colebrook - Tunnack road. Although the sandstone is a good aquifer, the topographical position of the property would preclude the striking of water at reasonable depths. Boring was not recommended and the application withdrawn.

Owen Wagner, Whiteford


The site of the bore is near the faulted boundary of Permian and Triassic sediments. Boring was recommended.

J.H. McShane, Stonehenge

The site of the bore was moved across the road to a flat probably underlain by sandstone. The proposed site was too close to a dolerite hill.

C.R. Brown, Paratfish

This property is on the outskirts of the town and underlain by sandstone. Boring was recommended.
