**Molybdenite-chalcopyrite on the Trenah–Camden road
(9095N 5490E)**

On the 8th May a visit was made to portion of the Trenah-Camden road in the company of Mr. L. Downs who found molybdenite-chalcopyrite mineralization in road cuttings.

The minerals occurred in granitic rocks as flakes or scales on joint planes, more rarely in quartz veins not wider than $\frac{1}{8}$ ".

The occurrence is of academic interest but of no economic value; the find, together with a similar one at Mt Stronach, may indicate a main lode at depth. This was pointed out to Mr. Downs as a possibility only, but that a close watch on future clearing and road making developments in the area may yield more information.

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
