Proposed boring — Bellerive Yacht Club

The Bellerive Yacht Club proposes to erect additional club facilities adjacent to the existing club. The present buildings are sited on an unknown thickness of filling overlying Triassic sandstone. The filling is thought to be a heterogeneous material containing among other things large logs.

It is proposed to put down three boreholes. On account of the material likely to be encountered it is recommended that a percussion plant would be most suitable. Drilling agreements have been forwarded to the secretary of the club and should be signed and returned in a few days. The club wishes to proceed with this work as soon as possible and would appreciate having the boring plant made available as soon as possible.
