## **Petrographic descriptions of specimens from Waratah**

Samples from drill hole FL2 at Waratah (695'6"-694'7", 694'7"-695' and 695'-697'4") have been examined and found to be all of similar composition, consisting of quartz and feldspar grains coated with fine grained clay-grade material, some colourless carbonate, magnetite, hematite and a little pyrite. No cassiterite was seen.
