Examination of sludge samples from Sulzberger's drill hole at Bracknell

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The sample, from 2230 feet, contains ilmenite, carbonate, chlorite, feldspar and ferromagnesians. There is little or no quartz and occasional composite fragments of plagioclase and stained ferromagnesians which seem to be of ophitic texture. The rock is probably a dolerite.

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
