Examination of a proposed subdivision at Rostella Road, Dilston

The area of this proposal, at Rostella Road Dilston, was examined at the request of the Tamar Regional Planning Authority. The area covered by Lot 2 is on a plateau and is flat, but below the break of slope in Lots 1 and 3, the slope is in active and catastrophic movement. Because of the tendency for this activity to regress uphill, any land greater than about 70 m from Rostella Road must be regarded as at risk. The use of Lots 1 and 3 is therefore severely restricted and building on them should not be contemplated.


