

STRATIGRAPHIC SEQUENCE

UNIT IV	PLIOCENE (?) - PLEISTOCENE	Reddish-brown sandy shale with thin layers of calcareous sand. Probably underlain by beds of Pliocene to and earlier origin.
UNIT III	MIOCENE (?)	Thin bedded shales, sandstones and calcareous sands.
UNIT II	OLIGOCENE - MIOCENE (?)	Shale and sandstone with thin layers of calcareous sand. 500' - 1000' thick. Draped over part of basin. Contains oil and some coal beds. High-angle folds exposed in deeper water environment.
UNIT I	OLIGOCENE (?)	Marine shales (?)
Basement	GRANITE, METAMORPHIC	Thick. Probably (?) bedded under southeast corner of basin. Possible patches under S.W. flank.
