



## CHAIN ADS-203 BASS STRAIT

SLAVE I ACCESS

Follow Princes Highway south from Sydney to Eden and on across the Border to Cann River. Turn left in village to Cape Everard (signposted).

The road deteriorates progressively and 4-wheel drive may be required in wet weather.

8 miles from Cann River take right-hand fork.

10 miles from Cann River take left-hand fork.

19 miles from Cann River cross small river with a flow-gauge - continue

26 miles from Cann River cross wide river, sand dunes opposite, sea to left.

27 miles from Cann River enter light house property - follow twisting track along sea edge.

29 miles from Cann River arrive at light house. Permission to enter light house property should be sought from Department of Shipping and Transport, Rialto House, Melbourne beforehand.

The Hi-Fix station marker consists of 18 inches of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch diameter galvanized iron pipe set in concrete 8 inches square. The above ground mark is a further 18 inches of galvanized iron pipe screwed into the lower. The station mast may be set exactly over the marker by upscrewing the top 18 inches, but a good chain wrench is required. It is not possible to set the mast alongside the marker since the pipe will extend above the mast insulation.
