

STATION: FITE (DROMEDARY)

LONGITUDE: 150° 01' 44".65 X 304632

LATITUDE: 36° 18' 35".33 Y 519277

ELEVATION: 820 YARDS (Approximately)

The position of this station was derived by offsetting the nearby "Dromedary" Trig. Station. The station is marked by a large round rock on a small clearing adjacent to the road and is approximately 210 yards south of Dromedary Trig. The station is located approximately ten miles west of the "Dromedary Trail" sign post marking the intersection about seven miles north of Central Tilba.

In August 1969 the last three miles of the road to the site was in very poor condition and if further deterioration occurs the road will be impassable to four wheel drive vehicles. The road is not maintained and before a decision is made to use this site again it would be advisable to check with Mr. & Mrs. Travis, General Store, Narooma. Good local information is also available from Mr. D. Rose, Narooma, who was most helpful in setting up the station and also has several four wheel drive vehicles he would make available. Any deterioration in the road condition could mean it would take at least three days to set up a station at this site.

Peter Baxter, Wagona Street, Narooma, has visited the site and could be useful as a camp helper.
