

STATION: Mt. William

LOCATED: On the most prominent hill in the extreme northeast corner of Tasmania on land owned by the British Tobacco Company.

ACCESS: Take the road east from Launceston to Derby, then another six miles to the Gladstone turn-off on the left. Follow this all the way into Gladstone and take the Ansons Bay road to the right. Follow this for about five miles until the Mussel Roe Bay road is seen on the left. This leads to the farmhouse where the manager of the British Tobacco Company lives. His house is about three miles west of the site. The tower and equipment was taken by crawler tractor and trailer to within 200 yards of the trig. site and handcarried the rest of the way.

ELEVATION: 236 yards.
