STATION: GENOA PEAK

LATITUDE: 37° 31' 54".39 N 370,485  
LONGITUDE: 149° 37' 38".81 E 267,316  
ELEVATION: 536 YARDS

ACCESS:

Follow the main highway through the town of Genoa towards Melbourne approximately one mile. The turnoff to Genoa Trail is plainly marked and travelling towards Melbourne it will be on the left. Follow this trail (road), which is plainly marked along its entire length, to the base of Genoa Peak. The station is on top of the peak which is a heap of huge boulders. A "Flying Fox" must be used to take equipment to the top of the peak. The distance from base to the top is about one half to three quarters of a mile. The Trig. Site and tower location are on a boulder about the size of a dining table. The camp site is about seventy feet away on top of another rock which is slightly larger.

Four days with a five or six man working party should be allowed to set this station and a similar time to take it down.
