



SKETCH. SEQUENCE OF MAIN EVENTS


Deposition of Mesozoic in elongated, graben-like trough.



Major break following Mesozoic deposition. Epeirogenic uplift and more localized uplift along east and west extremities of south flank. Erosional debris carried south.



Development of margin between continent and ocean basin, resulting in additional erosion of Mesozoic beds in the continental block. Typical of area from SS-23 eastward to OS-4.



Tertiary. Gentle, regional subsidence over stabilized framework of Mesozoic basin. Sediments deposited progressively southward on continental slope. Last 20-40 miles strongly fore-set.
