

A B S T R A C T

Project 659 was a Shoran positioned and controlled marine seismic survey for potential petroleum deposits in the Bass Strait off the coast of Victoria, Australia.

The principal was Hematite Petroleum Pty. Ltd. (HEMATITE).

Geophysical Service International (GSI) was the prime contractor and operator.

Offshore Navigation, Inc. (ONI) employed a Shoran radiolocation system to provide horizontal control for the survey.
