

V. FIELD OPERATIONS RECAP (continued)

Warrnambool for the purpose of Shoran calibration.

The following is a Daily Summary of Operations for the period 5 September 1973 to 13 September 1973.

5 September 1973 -

Shoran base station equipment to be used during this survey at Station Mt. Warrnambool. Shoran tower erected at this site. Base operator D. Sudderth. Also present were Mr. A. MacLean and Mr. P. Murray.

6 September 1973 -

Shoran mobile indicating equipment and Shoran tower erected at Station Mt. Richmond. Calibration of the Shoran base station equipment was accomplished between 1500 and 1800 hours. Average Shoran reading observed was 79.904 miles.

7 September 1973 -

Station Crowes installed. Base operator A. MacLean.

8 September 1973 -

Station Mount Richmond installed. Base Operator C. Debakker.

9 - 11 September 1973 -

ONI personnel standing by for the M/V EUGENE MCDERMOTT II to return to Portland to install the Shoran mobile indicating equipment.
