

Figure 7 is a southwest-northeast line which strikes across the basin. West of the Mornington - King Island Fault is the West Penguin lead followed by the Penguin lead, the central graben area and the Seal anomaly area. Further to the northeast, the section is very condensed.

Figure 13 is a northwest-southeast line which illustrates the rollover of the Penguin lead and the Mornington - King Island Fault.

Figures 8 and 9 are northeast-southwest dip lines which illustrate the Seal leads area.

Figures 10 and 11 are northwest-southeast strike lines which illustrate the Seal leads area.

Figure 14 is a northeast-southwest dip line which illustrates an unnamed lead far removed from the main Tertiary and pre-Tertiary depocenters.
