

## VI PROSPECTS AND LEADS

### VI.1 INTRODUCTION

Nine prospects and leads are presented here, each corresponding to one of the five playtypes described above in this report.

Chat Prospect represents a conventional Top and Intra EVCM playtype.

Spring Graben, Bark Graben and Dump Graben represent alluvial fans deposited on the downthrown side of a normal faults - a playtype associated with Late Cretaceous rifting.

Tamar prospect represents tilted block of Upper Cretaceous sediments against a basement fault.

Lily, Water Lily and South Lily represent structures along the Southern margin of the Bass Basin formed by either shale diapir or mid-Tertiary wrenching.

Sea Eagle (which is downgraded) represents Top Upper Cretaceous play on the upthrown side of a rift-related normal fault.
