BEECHFORD CALIBRATION RANGE

A SYLEDIS chain was calibrated on 3 November 1990 in the Beechford area over a known distance (7403.504 metres) between Beechford 341/050 and a 1.46m offset from Stony Head ST868 and repeated on 8 November 1990. A clear line of sight near water exists between these points.

7 metre towers were erected at each point, with mobiles installed at Beechford 341/050 and beacons at Stony Head ST868.

No permission was obtained to use the marker at Beechford as it is on public land and permission to occupy Stony Head was obtained from Major Ian Steele of 6th Military Barracks, Anglesea Barracks, Hobart, 7001.

A further, in situ calibration was performed on 8 November 1990 to confirm both the delay values and the positioning of the base stations.
