STATION NAME: East Sandy WGS88

LOCATION: Approximately 10 km north/northwest of Bridport on a prominent sand dune on the seaward side of a wire boundary fence north of the property airstrip.

ACCESS : If after 5 pm call on Graham Moore at 39 Westwood St Bridport (1 km past pub) to obtain the gate key. From Bridport proceed for approximately 4. km along the main Rd to a bridge, followed by a "T" junction and turn right. Proceed for 2 km to a gate on the left, set back from the road. From the gate drive 1km to a cattle grid and turn right across the airstrip to a gate adjacent to a small shed. From this gate drive to another gate along the fence line, from this gate drive WNW for 1 km and diverge back to the fenceline to avoid a large wet area. Follow the fence to the northeast corner and park, the mark is approximately 40m NNE of the fence junction.

MARKER : A 44 gallon drum filled with concrete, inscribed with "EAST SANDY" and "WGS 88". A steel spike protrudes from the centre of the concrete.
