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STATION NAME: Hardwickes Offset

LOCATION: Approximately 24km east of Bridport on a flat area of sand, below and to seaward of the telecom tower at Hardwickes hill

ACCESS : From Bridport drive east 24km to a sign, pointing right, marked "Scottsdadle 33". Continue east for 4km, over a bridge to a left turn 100m after the bridge, marked "Waterhouse protected area". Turn here and follow the dirt road for 8km, to where, on the final ascent, a boom gate is encountered. From the boom gate, proceed 1.5km to a small car park 5m from the compound gates. The offset is 10m WNW of the car park.

MARKER : A steel star picket, driven into the ground, with the top protruding 4cm above ground level.  
A 1m steel star picket, with an aluminium tag bearing the inscription "HGS34" affixed is used as a witness post, 1m at 0deg from the offset
