STATION NAME: Charmouth hill ST770

LOCATION: Approximately 3km NNW of Hugh Mills' farm buildings, atop a grassy hill at the NW corner of Cape Portland.

ACCESS : From Bridport, proceed for approximately 59 km to Gladstone. From Gladstone store drive east over a bridge to a fork in the road at 2km. Turn left and follow a dirt road, taking a right turn at 20.5km, after passing through a small hamlet "Rushy Lagoon". At 22km take a left fork into Hugh Mills' property and notify anyone available of your intentions. From here continue straight ahead, through 3 gates (to 24km) and follow the track as it turns left and continues uphill through 2 gates to Charmouth Hill. The beacon is visible from the farm buildings onwards.

MARKER : A brass mushroom, set in concrete, at ground level, stamped "770". A steel quad beacon was situated directly above the mark.

An offset of 1.2m at 160deg true (172deg magnetic) was used to avoid the beacon.
