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STATION NAME: Mt William ST746

LOCATION: Approximately 20km ENE of Gladstone, atop Mt William, the highest peak in Mt William National Park. Mt William is approximately 5km inland, between Cape Naturaliste and Eddystone Point.

ACCESS : From Gladstone, Drive east for 2km, over a bridge and turn right at the fork indicated "Musselroe" and "Poole". Proceed for 7km to a left turn marked "Musselroe" and "Poole", follow this road for 7km and halt at the brick rangers building, on the right, just within the Mt William National Park. In 1990 the ranger was Brian Carson, inform him of your intentions. From here continue 1km to a right turn, Forrester Kangaroo Drive, follow this road for approximately 5km to a fork in the road with the sea visible ahead. Turn right and drive for 1.5km to a car park, from this car park "Mt William Walking Trail" must be walked to the summit of Mt William, 40mins walk or 20mins jog up and 20+mins down. A helicopter may be loaded (with permission) at the airstrip, 500m along Forrester Kangaroo Drive from Musselroe Rd, 2km NW of Mt William.

MARKER : A copper tube, set in concrete within a gal pipe at ground level. A steel quad beacon is sited directly above the mark.
