

presence of a consistent intermingling of these multiple rock zones throughout the basin vertically and laterally suggest that the seismic expression of the Eastern View Coal Measures will not change significantly within the central basin. Therefore the major facies changes within the basin as described by P. G. Williamson et al. (1987) are not as dramatic as thought and would not be expressed seismically. This suggests that additional seismic-stratigraphy work within the central basin is not warranted.
