

A series of stacked channels (shallow subaqueous?, crevasse?) overlain by a crevasse splay and marsh sequences. Channel sands are medium to coarse grained and exhibit, horizontal, planar and contorted bedding. Marsh sediments exhibit abundant carbonaceous root structures.

* Core 11 (7433-7453 ft) Late Cretaceous

Coarse to very coarse grained episodic debris flows characterized by contorted/convolute bedding and associated dark gray lake shales which are truncated by a fining up channel sequence. These coarse to fine-grained sands are characterized by trough cross-stratification and contorted bedding.
