

II. FIELD OPERATIONS RECAP (continued)

ONA personnel and equipment went on board the M/V BASS TIDE at Launcheston at 0600 hours 8 January 1986, and installation of the mobile Maxiran equipment began. The vessel departed Launcheston at 1000 hours and proceeded to Bell Bay, arriving at 1300 hours. Installation of the Maxiran mobile equipment on board the vessel was completed at 1800 hours 8 January 1986.

The M/V BASS TIDE departed Bell Bay at 0025 hours 9 January 1986. Maxiran baselines were crossed between 0737 and 1625 hours. Baseline crossings are detailed in "Maxiran Calibration" of this report. The M/V BASS TIDE dropped anchor off Sorrel Point at 1650 hours 9 January 1986 and stood by for gale warnings and the arrival of the D/V MARGIE.

The M/V BASS TIDE departed Sorrel Point at 1510 hours 10 January 1986 and proceeded to Welshpool, passing over the proposed location at 2020 hours that date. Maxiran signals were reported good, and three-way fixes recorded were within plus or minus one meter. The vessel arrived at the Welshpool dock at 0620 hours 11 January and took
