positioning fix recorded at 1330 hours 15 January. The Maxiran system was secured at 1800 hours 16 January 1986 and personnel were instructed to dismantle the base stations.

The TRITON representative, Mr. Dave Scott, ONA mobile operator, and GPS receiver were transferred from the M/V BASS TIDE to the D/V MARGIE at 0800 hours 17 January 1986. The GPS receiver was operational and parameters loaded at 1100 hours. Four-satellite constellation fixes were recorded from 1314 to 1740 hours. Mr. Scott, the ONA mobile operator, and GPS receiver were transferred to the M/V BASS TIDE that evening.

The M/V BASS TIDE departed the well site at 0015 hours 18 January 1986 and proceeded to Welshpool, arriving at the Welshpool dock at 0830 hours. All ONA electronics were removed from the vessel and stored, along with the Maxiran base stations, at TRITON's warehouse by 1330 hours that date. ONA personnel were released from this survey on 20 January 1986.
