

STATION: LOW HEAD

LOCATED: The station is located in the Load Head Lighthouse compound, north of Georgetown, Tasmania, Australia.

ACCESS: From Launceston, drive on the East Taman Highway to Georgetown. Continue straight through Georgetown along Highway A8, which becomes Low Head Road. This road leads directly to the lighthouse along a bitumen road. The lighthouse is painted red and white.

MARKER: The trig point at this site is on the ground floor of the lighthouse. An offset marker was surveyed in. However, the offset marker was too close to the cliff to erect a tower. This required that the tower be erected 4.73 meters, at a bearing of 130°, from the offset marker. A marker was established at the tower location. It consists of concrete with the words "W.G. OFFSET 85" inscribed.

GENERAL: The lighthouse compound is under the authority of the Department of Transport, Hobart. Telephone 002-205288. Contact is Mr. Derrick Walter.
