60 Sandstone: Colourless translucent to transparent, fine to very coarse, predominantly fine to medium, subangular to subround, weak siliceous cement, trace to common white clay matrix and clay coatings on grains, friable, fair to good porosity, no show.
- 2655 - 2658 10 Claystone: As above.
90 Sandstone: Colourless to light brown, very fine to very coarse, very poorly sorted, angular to subangular, subspherical to elongate, weak siliceous cement with quartz overgrowths, strong sideritic cement of fine grained aggregates, trace brown and white interstitial clay, common fractured quartz grains, quartzose, trace chert and lithic grains, trace white feldspars, trace mica, friable, fair porosity, no show, common orange to yellow green mineral fluorescence.
- 2658 - 2661 60 Sandstone: As above, becoming predominantly fine to medium grained, well sorted, with strong sideritic cement and white matrix, friable to hard, poor to fair porosity, no show.
