	20	Siltstone: Off white to light grey to light brown, slightly argillaceous, carbonaceous laminae, micromicaceous, firm, laminated.

	20	Claystone: As above, becoming grey brown, micromicaceous, firm, subfissile to fissile, trace disseminated pyrite, occasionally silty.
	40	Sandstone: (1) As above, loose and unconsolidated. (2) Pale yellow, fine grained, well sorted, subround, clean, but with a very strong sideritic cement, very hard, no porosity, no show. Type (2) appears to be the same as type (1) but well cemented.
2061 - 2064	40	Sandstone: predominantly type (1), as above.
	40	Claystone: As above, becoming light brown soft and dispersive.

2064 - 2067	10	Coal: Black, dull, firm to hard, brittle, irregular fracture.
	10	Sandstone: As above.
	10	Siltstone: As above, becoming predominantly light brown, firm, with carbonaceous detritus, subfissile.
	70	Claystone: Tan to light brown, grey brown, non calcareous, micromicaceous, carbonaceous microlaminae, disseminated pyrite, very soft and dispersive, occasionally firm and subfissile.

2070 - 2073	90	Claystone: Tan to light brown, occasionally off white, non calcareous, micromicaceous, very soft, dispersive.
