5620 - 5650 feet Core No. 7 Cut 30 feet Rec. 23 feet

Siltstone : light grey to white grey in part. Very finely sandy, silty, argillaceous, sparsely micaceous and pyritic, sparsely fine grain and streaks of carbon material. Bedding is defined by fine laminae, dark grey brown argillaceous siltstone and silty shale. Porosity poor, permeability, poor, no show, odor taste nor fluorescence, bedding sub-horizontal, well defined foreset bedding to 30° in about one inch thick laminae worm burrows, also slumping and micro faulting.

5650 - 5680 feet

5680 - 5750 feet

Interbedded siltstone and sandstone as above.
