## 4. Details of Operation (contd.)

Casing programme: Not yet finalised, to be advised later.

- Logging programme:
- (1) Continuous mud logging from base of 20-inch casing to T.D.
  - (2) At surface casing point - IES and BHCS; take sidewall cores.
  - (3) At protective casing point - IES, BHCS, FDC, CDM, possibly MLL and N; a velocity survey will be run and sidewall cores taken. F.I.T.'s as required.
  - (4) At T.D., as above for protective casing point.

Samples: Catch 4 sets of cuttings at 10 foot intervals from the base of 20-inch casing to T.D.

Coring: Core all significant hydrocarbon shows. Take the following cores for stratigraphic control:

Jan Juc Fm (Torquay Gp) at 3031 feet (1);  
Demons Bluff Fm at 3731 feet (1);  
Eastern View C.M. at 4081 feet (2).

Thereafter cut 1 core (preferably in sand) at about 600 foot intervals to 7800 feet, and one core at T.D. of 10,000 feet.

Proposed Total Depth: 10,000 feet.
