90	3500 ft	<u>Marl</u> - mid grey, very firm, abundant white calcareous clay aligned sub-parallel to bedding.
91	3400 ft	<u>Marl</u> - light-mid grey, very firm, common large fossil fragments.
92	3320 ft	<u>Marl</u> - as above
93	3200 ft	<u>Marl</u> - mid grey, firm, common fossil fragments white calcareous clay.
94	3105 ft	Misfire.
95	3010 ft	<u>Marl</u> - as above, with abundant fossil fragments (forams, polyzoans, echinoids).
