

II. FIELD OPERATIONS RECAP (continued)

The M/V BASS TIDE departed Launceston at 0845 hours 9 July 1984 and proceeded to Bell Bay, arriving at 1135 hours that same date. The vessel departed Bell Bay at 1900 hours 9 July and checked the Maxiran system. The vessel returned to Bell Bay at 1100 hours 11 July. The Maxiran mobile equipment was removed from the vessel and transported to Station Doctors Rocks. The Maxiran system was checked for proper calibration on the Stations Doctors Rocks/Point Sorell baseline on 12 July 1984. See "Maxiran Calibration" of this report for details.

The ONA mobile operator and Maxiran mobile equipment went back on board the M/V BASS TIDE at Beauty Point on 12 July 1984, and the Maxiran equipment re-installed. The vessel departed Beauty Point at 0800 hours 13 July and proceeded to Welshpool, arriving at 2330 hours that same date. The M/V BASS TIDE departed Welshpool at 0300 hours 14 July and proceeded to the D/V DIAMOND M EPOCH, which was near Rabbit Island. The vessel arrived at the rig at 0530 hours 14 July, and departed at 0810 hours and proceeded to Barry's Beach. The vessel arrived at Barry's
