

II. FIELD OPERATIONS RECAP (continued)

Beach at 1005 hours 14 July 1984, and Mr. P. Munday, the Quality Control Coordinator, came on board.

The M/V BASS TIDE departed Barry's Beach at 1050 hours 14 July 1984 with Mr. Munday on board and returned to the D/V DIAMOND M EPOCH. The vessel departed the rig and proceeded to the well location area at 1700 hours, arriving in the location area at 2330 hours 14 July 1984.

The buoy pattern was set and checked between 0010 hours 15 July 1984 and 0721 hours that same date.

The M/V EASTERN TIDE was utilized to tow the D/V DIAMOND M EPOCH onto location and to handle anchors. The rig arrived at the well site, and anchoring operations began at 1402 hours 15 July 1984. The anchors were secured, and the final Maxiran reading was recorded at 0341 hours 16 July. Transit fixes were recorded between 1114 and 1332 hours 17 July, and an additional Maxiran three-way fix was recorded alongside the rig at 0911 hours 18 July. The Maxiran system was secured at 0930 hours 18 July
