

III. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Maxiran frequencies used were:

Mobile Transmitter	429 MHz
Base Transmitter	429 MHz

B. Satisfactory radiotelephone communications were maintained between the Maxiran stations on the frequency of 7840.0 (SSB) kilocycles.

C. The Maxiran field data accumulated during this survey was turned over to Mr. P. Munday, the TRITON representative, on 18 JULY 1984. The final Maxiran ranges recorded were transmitted to the ONA office in Perth, W.A. for final computation.

D. Three Maxiran base station installations were provided by ONA for this survey.

E. Three Maxiran base station sites were occupied to control the survey. They were:

STATION DOCTORS ROCKS (SPM 430)

STATION POINT SORELL (ST 517)

STATION THE NUT (ST 674)
