**ANNUAL REPORT EL22/2000 1SKM RINGAROOMA RIVER**

Although we have not achieved as much as we would have liked we are still pleased with our progress. Being a part time operation it is difficult to spend quality time in all areas.

**Track work.** Good progress has been made on the tracks. With the knowledge of some locals we have restricted the works as far as possible to old mining and woodcutters tracks. Some of these tracks we are pushing in over the tailings left behind as the river slowly returns to its original level. These tailings are some thirty feet above the river's present height, thereby causing as little disturbance as possible to the natural vegetation. The tracks have been made as safe as possible and whilst by the general public will not be encouraged it should be a safe walking track. Because most of the tracks are on tailings there is minimum tree and scrub to clear. Many of the trees removed have had a noticeable lean and being that they are only sitting on tailings had to be removed for safety reasons. Some of them had fell in the recent winds prior to our arrival. Since our last progress report we have cleaned approximately a further 1 km of track. There is only about 700 meters of track left to clear.

**Expenditure** The total expenditure to 30 Sept 2001 was \$8397.00. Since then a further \$950.00 has been spent on track cleaning making the total to date \$9297.00.

**Proposed activities for next year.** In the next year we should be able to spend more time proving the values. Once the equipment modifications are complete there are a number of beaches and tailings dumps now made accessible that can be tested.



